MISSING PERSON

2300-mile - On Saturday, September 06, 2014, near the 2300-mile of Sand Road, Marshall County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a missing adult who was believed to have gone swimming in the Iowa River near Albion, Iowa.

Kevin Kroener, age 52, was reported overdue by family members from swimming in the Iowa River at approximately 1740 hours. Based on information given by family members, Mr. Kroener's vehicle was located in a remote area near the Iowa River. A search was conducted in the vicinity along the river banks and wooded area near the Iowa River. After an extensive search of area, Mr. Kroener was not located. The search for Mr. Kroener was suspended due to darkness and safety concerns. The search for Mr. Kroener is scheduled to resume Sunday morning September 7th, 2014.
